UKAGP Organising Committee Role Summary

Trainee, Pre-Accreditation and Institute Engagement

The voices of gestalt practitioners in training are represented on the OC by the Trainee representative. This role supports UKAGP Constitutional objectives through engaging with this key constituent of our community of gestalt practitioners.

The role is usually held by either a current trainee, or a pre-accreditation practitioner who has the motivation to represent the voices of trainees as members of the UKAGP and to support dialogue between trainees of the various UK gestalt training institutions.

What to expect in this role?

A key aspect of this role is in the promotion of dialogue with the trainee gestalt practitioner community in order to ensure that the trainee voice is well represented on the UKAGP Organising Committee (OC).

In practice this has resulted in facilitating groups of trainees in order to allow themes to emerge, as with a recent Trainee Conference day. The role may include reporting surveys and other means of gathering information from the point of view of trainee gestalt practitioners, culminating each year with in a report to members at the AGM.
